

Landscape Committee Report April 10, 2025

The committee met several times since the March Board of Directors meeting. At this meeting, Directors approved expenditures of up to \$2,400 to remove the dying pine tree at the West Entrance and up to \$4,400 for removal of invasive plants and weeds on DCCE property (see the Invasive Plant and Weed Removal proposal).

The committee has accepted the Nicholas Tree Removal Service's quote to remove the dying pine tree for \$1,900.00. The work is scheduled for Tuesday, April 15, and no traffic disruption is expected.

The committee has accepted the Tradesman Tree and Landscape's quote to remove invasive plants and weeds on DCCE property for \$4,400.00. The work is scheduled to begin in mid-April.

Several committee members have begun work on developing a low water use landscape plan.
