Committee Report for May 21, 2025 Master Board Meeting

The Rules Committee met in mid-April to develop and implement final strategies in getting the amended and restated CC&R document over the April 30th finish line.

Direct outreach to homeowners who had not yet voted was conducted by committee members as well as sub-association members who had volunteered to help.

Messages on the sandwich boards located at the East and West entrances were changed weekly. Signs with the weekly message were placed at the five stop signs located on Master roads.

The fourth ballot counting session was held on May 2nd. One hundred twelve paper ballots were tallied that day – the ballot auditors were once again thanked for their assistance.

The committee later met to compile and review the final results. The results revealed that the effort to amend and restate the CC&R document had failed. The Directors and Presidents were notified of the result.

The Committee will present its full report at the May 21st Board of Directors meeting.
